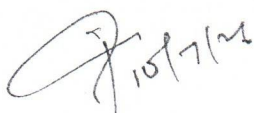

3. Definitions

Term	Definition
Solar crop dryer	A protected drying system using solar thermal energy and/or solar PV powered air circulation/control, with optional hybrid backup, used for controlled drying of agricultural and horticultural produce.
Batch capacity	Maximum wet produce loading for one drying batch under declared commodity-specific loading assumptions. Capacity shall not be stated only as chamber volume.
Food contact surface	Any tray, mesh, liner or surface directly touching produce during drying. It shall be food-grade and corrosion-resistant.
Commissioning	Completion of installation, safety checks, dry run, loaded test/demonstration, beneficiary training and issue of field acceptance certificate.
Hidden transit damage	Damage not visible during unloading but detected during installation, dry run, loaded trial or within 30 days of commissioning.
Comprehensive warranty	Warranty covering parts, labour, travel, repairs, replacement, service visits and software/controller defects without extra cost to BHDS or beneficiary.

5. Scope of Work

- Design, engineering, manufacture, factory testing, packing, loading, transit insurance, transportation, unloading, assembly, installation, testing and commissioning of solar crop dryers at sites approved by BHDS.
- Supply all components, including drying chamber/tunnel, trays/racks, cover/glazing, frame, fans/blowers, sensors, controller, solar PV modules, battery/inverter where applicable, wiring, earthing, safety devices, signage, QR asset label, manuals and installation accessories.
- Ensure the dryer is suitable for fruits, vegetables, spices, medicinal and aromatic plants, flowers, grains or other produce notified by BHDS, subject to crop-specific protocols issued during training.
- Provide one complete user manual, maintenance manual, warranty card, electrical safety sheet and crop-wise standard operating procedure in Hindi and English.
- Train the beneficiary/FPO/SHG users at site and capture training acknowledgement with geotagged photographs.
- Provide comprehensive warranty, preventive maintenance, corrective maintenance, spare parts and service reporting during the warranty period.
- Maintain a digital asset and service register for each installed dryer.

7. Minimum Technical Specifications

Parameter	Minimum requirement
Capacity declaration	Bidder shall declare wet batch load, tray area, tray loading density, indicative drying time for at least three commodities, and moisture reduction assumptions. Capacity shall not be declared only by chamber size.
Temperature range	Adjustable or controlled operating temperature generally 40-65 deg C depending on commodity; high temperature cutoff or warning at 70 deg C for produce safety.
Temperature uniformity	For 50 kg and above, temperature variation within chamber shall generally be within +/-5 deg C after stabilization under test conditions, or bidder shall state validated design basis.
Air flow	Forced air circulation mandatory for 50 kg and above. Fans/blowers shall be protected by guards and be replaceable at site.

9. Quality Assurance, Inspection and Testing

- The bidder shall submit a quality assurance plan covering procurement of materials, fabrication, component testing, electrical testing, chamber testing, packing and dispatch.
- BHDS may conduct factory inspection/testing.
- Pre-dispatch inspection (PDI) shall include model, capacity, BOM, serial numbers, tray count, food contact material, frame/corrosion protection, cover material, fan/controller/PV/battery details, electrical safety and packing quality.
- Field acceptance shall include physical verification, dry run, fan/controller test, temperature display test, electrical safety/earthing test, water ingress check, loaded demonstration wherever feasible and user training certificate.
- At least 5% of supplied units or minimum one unit per district/package, whichever is higher, may be randomly inspected in detail by BHDS/third party. BHDS may increase sampling if defects are found.

11. Transport, Transit Damage and Risk Allocation

- The quoted price shall include packing, forwarding, insurance, freight, loading, unloading, local handling and incidental charges up to the beneficiary/site.
- Supplier shall arrange transit insurance for full replacement value. Insurance claim process shall not delay replacement/commissioning for the beneficiary.
- Delivery acknowledgement is not acceptance. Payment shall not be released merely on delivery at site.
- Any visible damage at delivery shall be recorded and the damaged component/unit shall be replaced within 7 days or within a period approved by BHDS considering site conditions.
- Any hidden damage detected during installation, commissioning or within 30 days of commissioning shall be presumed supplier responsibility unless misuse, tampering or force majeure is established by written inspection report.
- Repeated transit damage or poor packing may lead to rejection of batch, suspension of further dispatches, penalty and de-empowerment proceedings.

12. Warranty, Maintenance and Service Level Agreement

Comprehensive system warranty	Minimum 5 years from commissioning covering parts, labour, travel and replacement at no extra cost.
Structure durability	Minimum 7 years against normal corrosion/failure subject to user not physically damaging the unit.

14. Penalties and Safeguard Mechanism

Default	Action/Penalty
Delay in supply/installation	Liquidated damages at 0.5% of delayed unit/work order value per week or part thereof, subject to maximum 10%, without prejudice to cancellation.
Visible transit damage	No payment for damaged unit/component. Replacement within 7 days; repeated cases attract penalty up to 2% of affected unit value and dispatch suspension.
Hidden damage within 30 days	Free repair/replacement within prescribed SLA. Failure permits BHDS to arrange repair/replacement at supplier risk and cost.

15. Allocation of Work among Empanelled Agencies

- Empanelment does not guarantee work. Work orders may be issued based on beneficiary choice, district requirement, scheme priority, capacity package, past performance, service performance, complaint record, availability of funds and administrative convenience.
- BHDS may restrict fresh work orders to agencies with unresolved complaints, repeated SLA failures or poor field performance, even if empanelled.
- BHDS may require multiple agencies to agree to finalized rate/package terms where permitted, but quality thresholds and warranties shall not be diluted.

16. Disqualification and Termination

- Submission of late, incomplete, conditional or materially deviating bid.
- Failure to meet eligibility or mandatory technical gate.
- Attempt to influence, canvass or interfere with evaluation.
- Blacklisting/debarment or concealment of material facts.
- Forged certificates, false performance claims, altered test reports or misrepresentation.
- Failure to establish service support in Bihar within the committed time.
- Supply of substandard materials or failure to honour warranty/SLA obligations.
- Repeated complaints verified by district officials, third-party inspectors or BHDS committee.

17. Empanelment Validity

- The empanelment shall remain valid for a period of two (02) financial years from the date of issuance of the Empanelment Order and may be extended for a further period of one (01) financial year, subject to satisfactory performance and successful completion of assigned works, at the discretion of BHDS.
